**Na-Me-Res have been providing services to Aboriginal men who are homeless since 1985. As a culture-based organization we endeavour to provide services which meet the spiritual, physical, emotional and mental health needs of our clients. Our programs and services include:**

- **The Men’s Shelter** is an abstinence based 63 bed shelter which serves a diverse population. Building on their strengths, staff assist clients develop a realistic personal development plan designed to assist them secure permanent housing.
- **Special Needs Service**—A disproportionate number of our client have special needs sometimes as a result of the inter-generational effects of colonization including residential school syndrome. This service offers a specialized response for those with special needs.
- Through our **Outreach Services** we work with people living outdoors and in seasonal shelters assisting them to secure permanent housing. We also provide a supportive aftercare service for those newly housed.
- **Our Sagatay Program** provides clients with a safe and supportive living and learning environment where they are provided with every opportunity to develop all the resources required to succeed in the broader urban environment as strong self-confident and self-sufficient Aboriginal men.

We also offer our clients the opportunity to participate in **cultural activities** including sweat, healing circles, workshops, access to traditional healers and elder – access to the **Credit Program** which provides them with a work placement where they earn credits which they can use to secure permanent housing – our **Annual Traditional Pow Wow** is held every year in June. Of all the special holidays throughout the year, “Christmas”/Winter Solstice is a most lonely and desolate time for the many of our clients. Each year we conduct a “Christmas Drive” so we can provide them with a special day.
