Applicant Suitability

- demonstrate stability with any potential addiction and/or mental health issues
- Aboriginal men 16 years of age and up
- Ready to commit to program policies
- Ability to identify long and short term goals

Apaenmowinneen

“having confidence in myself”

- 3 month mandatory participation with an option of continuing to 6 months
- Mon to Fri from 9:30 – 3:30
- Develop life skills and confidence
 - Communication
 - Problem solving
 - Traditional studies
 - Employability skills
 - Healthy living
 - Personal identity



After Apaenmowinneen

- Once clients have graduated from the Apaenmowinneen program they move into the “Three Streams”:
 - Employment
 - Volunteering
 - Continuing Formal Education
- “Three Streams” are self directed and encourage clients to continue working towards their goal of self sufficiency and self reliance
- Clients can also move directly into the work force or into formal training/education – as long as they are keeping busy and staying focused

Sagatay Case Management

- Care Team
 - Case Manager
 - Client Support Worker
 - Housing Support and follow up support
 - Oshkabaywis
- Programming and Employment Support
 - Coordinator of client training
 - Job developer
- Special Needs Support
 - Special needs coordinator
 - Registered nurse
 - psychiatrist
- Special Guest Support
 - Traditional Elders
 - Traditional Healers



Substance Use

- Sagatay is an abstinence based program and promotes a substance use free lifestyle
- Those returning under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed in the building
- Sagatay recognizes that relapse may occur and will deal with each incident on a case by case basis
- Discharge may occur after a relapse but is not certain

Common Misconceptions

- Sagatay is not designed or able to meet the needs of individuals in an addictive lifestyle or with un-addressed and severe mental health issues
- Sagatay is NOT a treatment centre
- Appropriate Sagatay applicants should be looking for more than housing

Re-admission

- Participants who have been discharged are welcome to re-apply
- Same process will apply and reason of discharge will be considered
- Applicants who have not been accepted after interview, will be given some recommendations and are encouraged to re-apply



Sagatay graduates will be equipped with the resources required to succeed in the community as strong self confident and self-sufficient Aboriginal men
