Below are the rules that apply to all traders/vendors:

- The **allotted spaces are 10'X10'** for each craft vendor.
- Vendors are only allowed to sell at their designated area.
- Please keep the space around your booth, as well as after you leave, clean and free from debris.
- Vendors will be provided with one, 6-foot table.
- All vendors must provide a gift for the giveaway.
- Vendors must only sell First Nations, Inuit and Métis authentic arts, crafts, or goods. Vendors must a member of a First Nation, Inuit, or Métis community
- The following items are prohibited:
 - Face painting
 - "non-authentic crafts"
 - Petitions or any political propaganda
 - Raffles or games of chance
 - Food sales
- No refunds will be given.
- NMR Pow Wow is not responsible for personal loss or injury, or for financial loss, you may incur because of your participation in this event.
- All vehicles must be out of the pow wow grounds (area) by 10 am as gates will open at 10 am
- The venue does not proved electricity,
- No pets are allowed in the Pow Wow arena (dancing circle), except for service animals.
- Set up begin Saturday morning at 8 AM.
- All vendor spots are limited, please submit your application as soon as possible to secure a spot.

Payment's (Craft Vendor):

- \$300 Plus 1 item for giveaway
 - The morning of the event you will register at the Na-Me-Res table, where you will sign in, received your booth (location) number, and present the giveaway item.
- **All payment due by April 14th (no exceptions)**
- **We require a certified cheque or money order made payable to Na-Me-Re Native Men's Residence**
