## Below are the rules that apply to all Food vendors:

- Food vendors are to sell food only.
- No pets are allowed in the Pow Wow arena. With exception of service animal
- This is a drug and alcohol-free event.
- The allotted spaces are 10'X10' for each vendor.
- Vendors are only allowed to sell at their designated area.
- Please keep the space around your booth, as well as after you leave, clean and free from debris.
- Vendors will be provided with one, 6-foot table.
- All vendors must provide a gift for the giveaway.
- No refunds will be given.
- NMR Pow Wow is not responsible for personal loss or injury, or for financial loss, you may incur because of your participation in this event.
- All vehicles must be out of the pow wow grounds (area) by 10 am as gates will open at 10 am
- The venue does provide electricity. All vendors must be self sufficient.
- Set up begin Saturday morning at 8 AM.
- All vendor spots are limited, please submit your application as soon as possible to secure a spot.
- Vendors must adhere to all public health regulations. This includes temperature checking your food, hand washing stations, registering with public health, sanitizer spray.
- You must keep money and food separate.
- Absolutely NO grease disposal.
- A public health inspector may be onsite during the event to conduct an inspection of the food vendors' booth.
- It is the responsibility of each Special Event Food Vendor to be in full compliance with the following requirements. Failure to comply will result in Public Health's refusal to allow operations or lead to enforcement actions.

## Payment's (Food Vendor):

- \$350 Plus giveaway item (June 17, 2023, Pow Wow)
  - The morning of the event you will register at the Na-Me-Res table, where you will sign in, received your booth number, and present the giveaway item.
- All payment due by April 14<sup>th</sup> (no exceptions)
- We require a certified cheque or money order made payable to Na-Me-Re Native Men's Residence
- Once selected as a food vendor you are required to complete a Toronto Public Health Special Event Temporary Food Establishment package.
